
COVID-19 Impact survey #4





OVERVIEW

Starting to see more encouraging indicators with France, South Korea, and the United Kingdom reporting the virus is now starting to level off. Italy and Spain are reporting a decrease.

In almost all countries restrictions are being placed on travel of people. Only the USA and UK are still allowing some international travel. All countries have also placed some restrictions on domestic travel except Japan.

More regions are reporting higher instances of manufacturing facilities being closed due to Covid-19. Nine countries reporting at least 20% of facilities are now closed. Of those, six report closures of greater than 40%. These closures and circumstances surrounding Covid-19 are negatively impacting the overall business climate in all countries.

New orders are now being dramatically negatively impacted. Half of the reporting countries are seeing a reduction in new orders between 26-50 percent while the remaining half are seeing reductions between 51-75 percent.

Almost all countries are now dealing with transportation issues and border closing issues that negatively impact the ability for business to be conducted.





Has international travel for people been banned at this point?


Since April 7, two more countries, France and South Korea, have now banned international travel. Only the UK and USA are still allowing international travel to some extent.

Approximately half of the reporting countries have seen some restrictions placed on imports and exports on some commodities.





Has domestic travel of people been banned at this point?


At this point Japan is the only country not banning domestic travel. All other reporting countries indicate varying level of restrictions.

All countries indicating a significant negative impact in the business climate today.




SD = Companies are seeing some disruption in getting parts and components

What is the economic impact on new orders being taken for agriculture equipment whole goods?




